

9 Hounds named All – County; Adams named County pitcher of the year

The Greyhounds set a school record in 2017 by having 9 Hounds recognized by the Marietta Daily Journal as All County Softball players. 3 Hounds were named to the 1st team, 1 to the 2nd team and 5 Hounds were named honorable mention.

Freshman Hallie Adams took home top honors for her position as she was named ***Cobb County PITCHER OF THE YEAR!*** Adams is only the second Greyhound in school history to be named county pitcher of the year following in the footsteps of Kelly Barnhill who took home this honor in 2012 and 2013. Adams posted a 1.08 ERA in 2017 with 2 no hitters and a 17-3 record. Adams also threw 8 shutouts with 141 K's in 110 innings. Cobb County pitcher of the year is one of the top honors in the state as Cobb County is a softball hot bed in the state and Adams was selected from a pool of over 20 high schools representing multiple different classifications!

Joining Adams on the 1st team are senior outfielders Hannah Rogers and Lea McFadden. Both Rogers and McFadden earn 1st team honors for the 2nd time in their careers as McFadden was named 1st team in 2015 and Rogers named 1st team in 2016. Roger hit .455 with a single season Pope record 26 stolen bases in 2017 and McFadden hit a career high .424 with 32 RBIs and a team high 14 2bs.

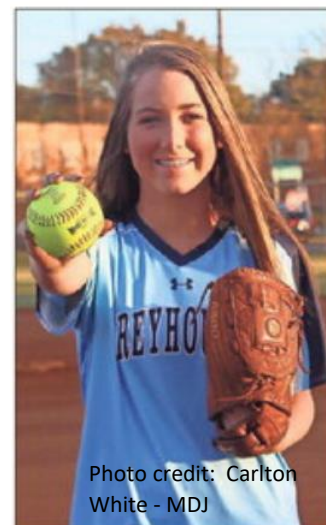
