

Pope Fastpitch concludes record breaking regular season; Set to host region Championship

The Pope Fastpitch softball team concluded the winningest regular season in school history this week amassing 23 regular season wins and compiling a 23-3 record. The 23 wins bests the previous regular season win total of 21 was accomplished on two different occasions; the 2012 season and the 2014 season. In each of the previous record breaking seasons, the Pope Softball team played for the State Championship, winning the title in 2014 and finishing state runner up in 2012.



In the process of winning 23 games this season, Pope finished with the best record in Region 7-AAAAAA with a 15-1 region record. Finishing 1st in the region during regular season qualifies Pope to not only play in the best of 3 region championship series, but to host the series at

Pope. 2017 marks the 3rd time in school history that Pope will host the region championship as the other 2 occasions were also the 2012 and 2014 seasons. Pope's lone region championship was won in 2012 as Pope bested Creekview in a best of 3 series.

En route to the record breaking 2017 season, Pope has posted a school best 14 game winning streak and has won 18 of its last 19 games since beginning the season 5-2. During the winning streak, Pope also set a school record by posting 7 consecutive shutouts.

The region championship series will be October 4th and 5th and the 1st round of the State playoffs will be October 13th and 14th and will also be hosted at Pope.
