

Georgia Dugout club awards the Greyhounds State player of the Year & Coach of the Year

At a ceremony held at the Marietta county club on January 16th 2019, the Georgia Dugout Club honored 2 Greyhounds with top honors as Zoe Laneaux was named 6A State player of the year and head coach Chris Turco was named 6A State Head coach of the year.

Zoe Laneaux is only the 3rd Greyhound to win the prestigious player of the year award as she follows in the footsteps of Laura Beall in 2012 and Kelly Barnhill in 2014. During the 2018 season, Laneaux set a myriad of records for the Hounds earning the most BB in the state in 2018 with a school record 37 walks which helped to bolster her on base percentage to a school best .661 eclipsing the former school record by a whopping 107 points! Zoe also tied Beall's 2012 school record .494 average to join Beall atop the leader board in batting average. Laneaux also added 12 2bs, 5 HR, and 29 RBI's and a program best 1.529 OPS.

Turco captures his 3rd GADC coach of the year award to follow up on awards in 2012 and 2014. This season, the Greyhounds won the 2018 region 7-AAAAAA championship as well as made a trip to Columbus for the 3rd year in a row and 6th time in the past 7 seasons. Turco guided the Hounds to their 3rd state championship appearance in the past 7 seasons and set a school record for wins in 2018 with 33 wins.
