

## Pope Fastpitch JV game summaries

### **Pope 1 – Creekview 11 – (0-1)**

The Pope JV season got off to a rocky start as the young hounds were 3 hit by an impressive performance by the Creekview pitcher.

Christian Tan, Lindsey Monkiewicz, and Samantha Crabtree all had hits for the Hounds with Monkiewicz knocking a triple in the 3<sup>rd</sup>. Monkiewicz came home to score on an error on the next play.

### **Pope 6 – Milton 3 – (1-1)**

The Greyhounds regain their form as they post their first victory against the Eagles of Milton High School. CJ Moran pitched 3 innings for the Hounds and secured her first career win and Devyn Smith pitched the final 2 innings of the time shortened game to secure the save.

The Hounds were led by Monkiewicz, Crabtree and Kyra Williamson who each knocked home 2 hits for the Hounds. Willimason had 2 RBI's as well as Olivia Pittarelli knocking in 2 runs.
